



TOP 10 HINTS FOR MAKING GREAT BLANKET TENTS:

- Ask a grown-up first! They need to know when you rearrange their furniture. And who knows, they might have fun helping you!
- Move your furniture close enough to hang sheets between them to make the roof of your tent.
- Light sheets are good for making the roof, and heavier blankets are good for warm, snuggly ground cover.
- To make a high roof, tie vines (or strings if you don't have any vines) across the room and hang your sheets over them. Always make sure you tie the string to things that won't fall over!

RIBBERT THE FROG'S FROZEN LOLLIES

INGREDIENTS

- 2 kiwis peeled & chopped
- 1 cup pineapple chopped
- 6 mint leaves
- 1 ripe banana
- 1 cup apple juice

METHOD:

- Combine all ingredients in blender and blend until smooth.
- Pour mixture into popsicle molds and let set in the freezer for 3 hours.
- Insert popsicle sticks into each molding, and let set for an additional 4 hours, or until completely frozen.
- Take one out on the next sunny day, and enjoy this sweet treat!





HUMPH'S LAMINGTONS

INGREDIENTS

- 125g butter, softened
- 1 cup caster sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract
- 3 eggs
- 1 ¾ cups self-raising flour, sifted
- 1/2 cup milk

CHOCOLATE SAUCE

- 3 1/2 cups icing sugar mixture
- 1/4 cup cocoa powder
- 1 Tbsp butter, softened
- 1/2 cup boiling water
- 2 cups desiccated coconut





METHOD:

- 1 Preheat oven to 180°C
- 2 Grease a 3cm-deep, 20cm x 30cm pan.
- 3 Using an electric mixer, beat butter, sugar and vanilla until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.
- 4 Sift half the flour over butter mixture. Stir to combine.

- 5 Add half the milk. Stir to combine. Repeat with remaining flour and milk
- 6 Spoon into prepared pan.
- **7** Bake for 30 minutes or until a skewer inserted in centre comes out clean.
- **8** Let stand in pan for 10 minutes. Turn out onto a wire rack. Cover with a clean tea towel. Set aside to cool.

MAKE THE SAUCE WHILE THE CAKE IS COOLING:

- 1 Sift icing sugar and cocoa into a bowl.
- 2 Add butter and boiling water. Stir until smooth.
 Cut cake into approximately 16 pieces. Place coconut in a flat dish.
- 3 Cut into smaller pieces if you want.
 Using a fork, dip one piece of cake in icing. Shake off excess
- 4 Toss in coconut. Place on a wire rack over a baking tray.
- 5 Repeat with remaining cake, sauce and coconut.



CHUNKI MUNKI FLAPJACKS

INGREDIENTS

- 1 cup cake flour
- 1 eggs
- 40ml castor sugar
- 25ml melted butter
- 2.5ml salt
- 10ml baking powder
- 125ml milk

METHOD:

- 1 Sift all the dry ingredients together in a bowl.
- 2 Mix all the wet ingredients together
- 3 Add all the ingredients and mix with a whisk until there are no lumps. Don't over mix.

COOKING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Heat up non-stick pan
- Pour batter in pan to make3 different sizes (face, mouth and ears)
- 3 Only flip over once
- 4 Repeat until the batter is finished
- 5 Let the flapjacks cool slightly.
- 6 Now it's time to DECORATE!



VANILLA CUPCAKES

INGREDIENTS

- 11/2 cups cake flour
- 11/2 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 tsp fine salt
- 2 large eggs
- 2/3 cup castor sugar
- 2 125g butter, melted
- 2 tsp vanilla extract




METHOD:

- 1 Preheat the oven to 180°C.
- 2 Line one 12-cup standard muffin tin.
- **3** Sift the flour, baking powder and salt together in a medium bowl.
- 4 In another medium bowl, beat the eggs and sugar with an electric mixer until light and foamy, about 2 minutes. While beating, slowly pour in the melted butter and then the vanilla.
- 5 While mixing slowly, add half of the flour mixture. Then add all the milk, followed by the remaining flour mixture.
- 6 Don't overmix the batter.
- **7** Divide the batter evenly in the prepared muffin tin.
- 8 Bake for 15 to 18 minutes.
- 9 Cool the cupcakes in the tin on a rack for 10 minutes, then remove from the tin and cool on the rack completely.
- 10 Frost and decorate as desired.







YOUR OWN FIREFLY PLANE!

With paper, scissors and tape, you can make a paper aeroplane with wings that buzz just like Ray the Firefly!


- it again, you will have a square.
- Fold one corner of the square into the middle and flatten the paper. Fold that side into the middle again, flatten it, fold it again, and flatten it again. Fold the rolled-up paper up over the diagonal middle line, and flatten it again. You will now have a triangle of paper, with a rolled-up strip of paper along the long edge.
- Without making any creases, bring the two sharp points of 3 the triangle together and join them by pushing one side into the other. Use tape to hold them together.
- From the paper left over after making the square, cut off a strip of paper. Tape it to the top of the plane.
- The firefly plane is complete! When you throw it, the wings will flap like a flying insect!


- Pour the clear glue into a bowl
- Add a little bit of purple food colouring.
 You don't need too much!
- Add some glitter

- If you are using borax, make a borax mixture by adding 1 teaspoon of borax to 1 cup of warm water and stir well to combine
- Pour the borax or liquid starch into your bowl, little by little, and keep stirring until your slime is the right consistency
- When your slime begins to form, take it out of the bowl and knead it with your hands. Keep adding a little more borax or liquid starch at a time and kneading until the slime isn't sticky, but not so much that it gets stiff
- If it does get stiff, just add a little water to make it soft and stretchy again!


