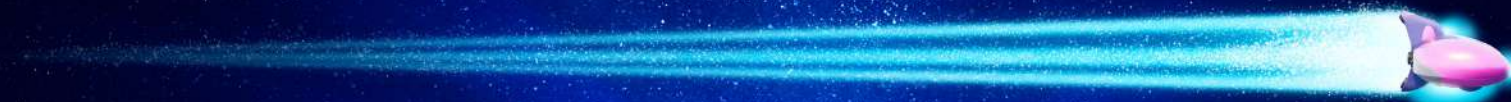

You can do it however you want. There's no wrong way!
Here are a couple of ideas to get you going...

TOP 10 HINTS FOR MAKING GREAT BLANKET TENTS:

1

Ask a grown-up first! They need to know when you rearrange their furniture. And who knows, they might have fun helping you!

2

Move your furniture close enough to hang sheets between them to make the roof of your tent.

3

Light sheets are good for making the roof, and heavier blankets are good for warm, snuggly ground cover.

4

To make a high roof, tie vines (or strings if you don't have any vines) across the room and hang your sheets over them. Always make sure you tie the string to things that won't fall over!

5

Pillows and stuffed animals will make the inside of the tent extra comfy. Jungle animals are the best!

6

If your roof sheets keep falling, try using clothes pegs to keep them up!

7

See if you can connect a lot of blanket tents together to make a gigantic mega-tent!

8

For a super easy tent, hang sheets over the side of a table and snuggle up underneath!

9

Don't forget to have an opening in your tent so you can see your TV, and everyone inside can watch **JUNGLE BEAT: THE MOVIE!**

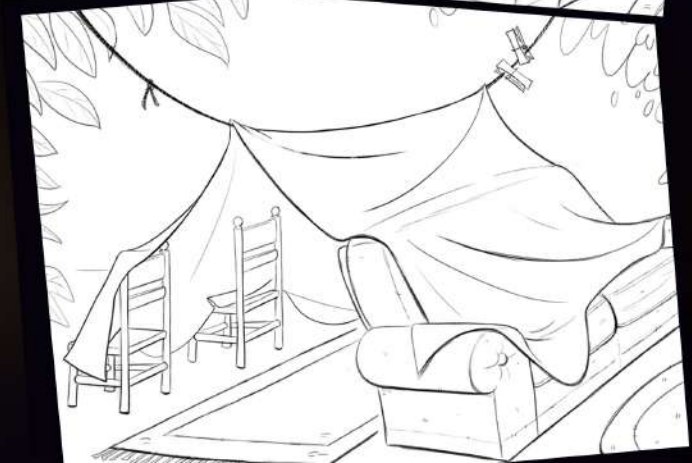

OSTRICH EGG NESTS



INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 1 cup shredded coconut
- ✓ 1/2 cup peanuts
- ✓ 1 cup chocolate chips
- ✓ 24 mini eggs / jelly beans

METHOD:

- 1 Preheat oven to 200°C.
- 2 Spread the shredded coconut & peanuts onto a baking sheet for toasting.
- 3 Place in oven for 5-10 minutes, until coconut & peanuts are a light golden brown colour.
- 4 Let it cool on baking sheet while melting chocolate.
- 5 Add chocolate chips to a microwave-safe bowl and melt in 20-30 second intervals until the chocolate is melted.
- 6 Add cooled coconut, peanuts and melted chocolate into a large bowl and toss to combine.
- 7 Use a spoon or ice cream scoop to scoop about 2-3 tablespoons of the chocolate mixture onto a piece of greased parchment paper and shape into a nest.
- 8 Top each nest with 2-3 eggs. Repeat with remaining ingredients.
- 9 Let nests set at room temperature or place in the fridge to speed up the process.



RIBBERT THE FROG'S FROZEN LOLLIES

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 2 kiwis - peeled & chopped
- ✓ 1 cup pineapple - chopped
- ✓ 6 mint leaves
- ✓ 1 ripe banana
- ✓ 1 cup apple juice

METHOD:

- 1 Combine all ingredients in blender and blend until smooth.
- 2 Pour mixture into popsicle molds and let set in the freezer for 3 hours.
- 3 Insert popsicle sticks into each molding, and let set for an additional 4 hours, or until completely frozen.
- 4 Take one out on the next sunny day, and enjoy this sweet treat!





MUNKI SNACKS

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 2 bananas
- ✓ 100gr chocolate chips

METHOD

- 1 Melt the chocolate in a glass bowl in the microwave, checking it every 30 seconds.
- 2 Don't overheat, otherwise it will burn
- 3 Peel the bananas and cut them half, lengthwise
- 4 Skewer the banana halves
- 5 Dip them in the melted chocolate
- 6 Sprinkle over the nuts
- 7 Place on a pan with greased parchment paper and freeze for 2+ hours

HUMPH'S LAMINGTONS



INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 125g butter, softened
- ✓ 1 cup caster sugar
- ✓ 1 tsp vanilla extract
- ✓ 3 eggs
- ✓ 1 ¾ cups self-raising flour, sifted
- ✓ 1/2 cup milk

CHOCOLATE SAUCE

- ✓ 3 1/2 cups icing sugar mixture
- ✓ 1/4 cup cocoa powder
- ✓ 1 Tbsp butter, softened
- ✓ 1/2 cup boiling water
- ✓ 2 cups desiccated coconut



METHOD:

- 1 Preheat oven to 180°C
- 2 Grease a 3cm-deep, 20cm x 30cm pan.
- 3 Using an electric mixer, beat butter, sugar and vanilla until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition.
- 4 Sift half the flour over butter mixture. Stir to combine.
- 5 Add half the milk. Stir to combine. Repeat with remaining flour and milk.
- 6 Spoon into prepared pan.
- 7 Bake for 30 minutes or until a skewer inserted in centre comes out clean.
- 8 Let stand in pan for 10 minutes. Turn out onto a wire rack. Cover with a clean tea towel. Set aside to cool.

MAKE THE SAUCE WHILE THE CAKE IS COOLING:

- 1 Sift icing sugar and cocoa into a bowl.
- 2 Add butter and boiling water. Stir until smooth. Cut cake into approximately 16 pieces. Place coconut in a flat dish.
- 3 Cut into smaller pieces if you want. Using a fork, dip one piece of cake in icing. Shake off excess.
- 4 Toss in coconut. Place on a wire rack over a baking tray.
- 5 Repeat with remaining cake, sauce and coconut.



CHUNKI MUNKI FLAPJACKS

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 1 cup cake flour
- ✓ 1 eggs
- ✓ 40ml castor sugar
- ✓ 25ml melted butter
- ✓ 2.5ml salt
- ✓ 10ml baking powder
- ✓ 125ml milk

METHOD:

- 1 Sift all the dry ingredients together in a bowl.
- 2 Mix all the wet ingredients together
- 3 Add all the ingredients and mix with a whisk until there are no lumps. Don't over mix.

COOKING INSTRUCTIONS

- 1 Heat up non-stick pan
- 2 Pour batter in pan to make 3 different sizes (face, mouth and ears)
- 3 Only flip over once
- 4 Repeat until the batter is finished
- 5 Let the flapjacks cool slightly.
- 6 Now it's time to DECORATE!



GALAXY MILKSHAKE

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 2 cups vanilla ice cream
- ✓ 1 cup milk
- ✓ 1 cups frozen blueberries
- ✓ 2 Tbsp honey / maple syrup
- ✓ Whipped cream, fresh berries (optional)

METHOD:

- 1 In a blender, puree all of the ingredients until thick and smooth.
- 2 Pour into 2 glasses.
- 3 Garnish with whipped cream, sweets & glitter



VANILLA CUPCAKES

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 1 1/2 cups cake flour
- ✓ 1 1/2 tsp baking powder
- ✓ 1/4 tsp fine salt
- ✓ 2 large eggs
- ✓ 2/3 cup castor sugar
- ✓ 125g butter, melted
- ✓ 2 tsp vanilla extract
- ✓ 1/2 cup milk

METHOD:

- 1 Preheat the oven to 180°C.
- 2 Line one 12-cup standard muffin tin.
- 3 Sift the flour, baking powder and salt together in a medium bowl.
- 4 In another medium bowl, beat the eggs and sugar with an electric mixer until light and foamy, about 2 minutes. While beating, slowly pour in the melted butter and then the vanilla.
- 5 While mixing slowly, add half of the flour mixture. Then add all the milk, followed by the remaining flour mixture.
- 6 Don't overmix the batter.
- 7 Divide the batter evenly in the prepared muffin tin.
- 8 Bake for 15 to 18 minutes.
- 9 Cool the cupcakes in the tin on a rack for 10 minutes, then remove from the tin and cool on the rack completely.
- 10 Frost and decorate as desired.

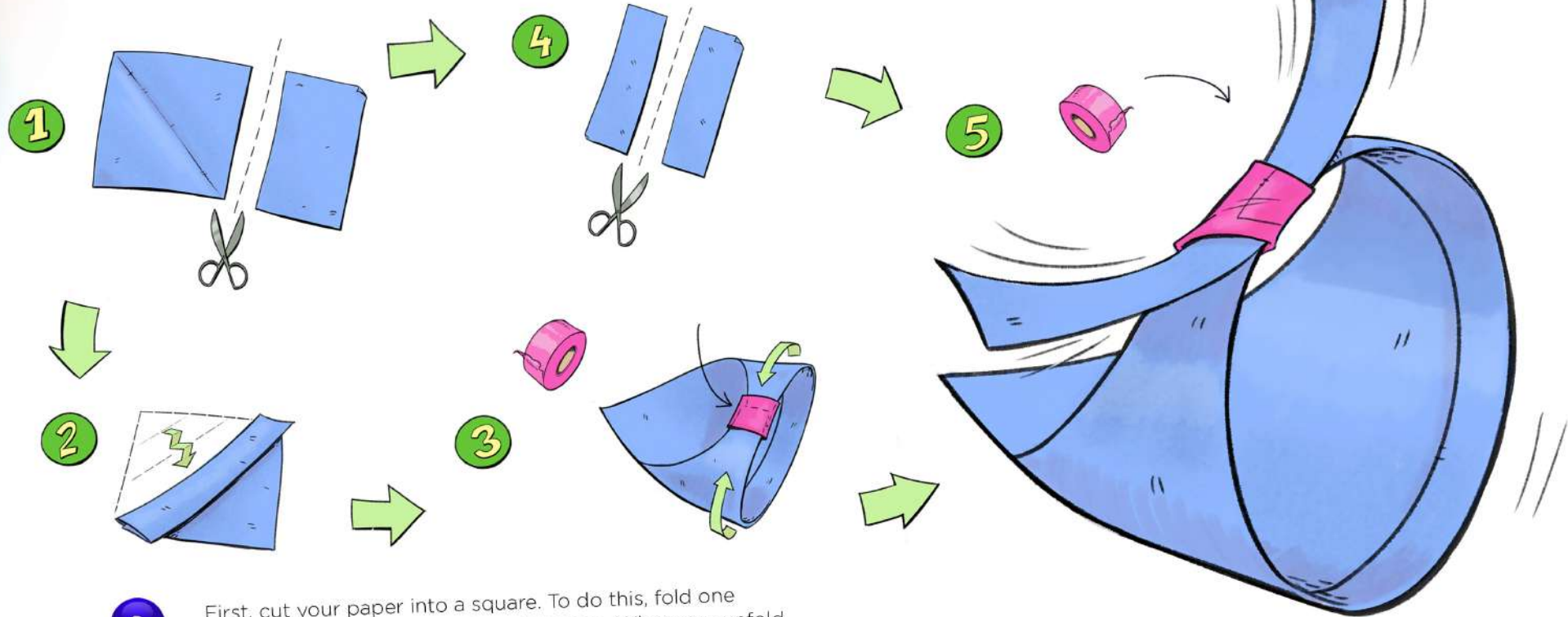

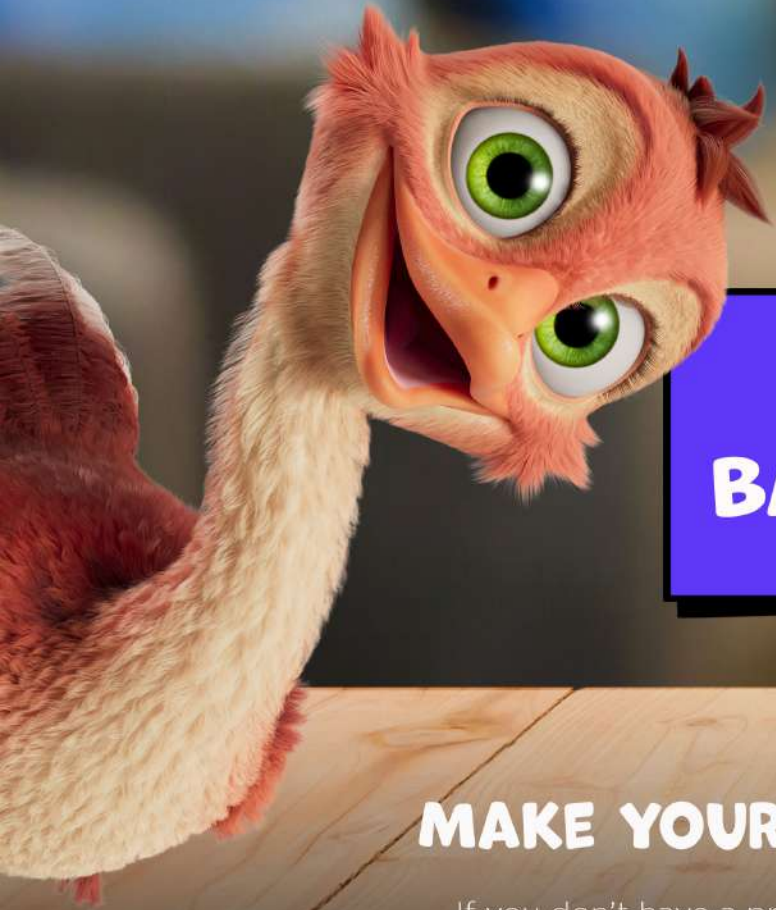
MAKE YOUR OWN FIREFLY PLANE!

With paper, scissors and tape, you can make a paper aeroplane with wings that buzz just like Ray the Firefly!



- 1** First, cut your paper into a square. To do this, fold one corner over, and then cut along the edge. When you unfold it again, you will have a square.
- 2** Fold one corner of the square into the middle and flatten the paper. Fold that side into the middle again, flatten it, fold it again, and flatten it again. Fold the rolled-up paper up over the diagonal middle line, and flatten it again. You will now have a triangle of paper, with a rolled-up strip of paper along the long edge.
- 3** Without making any creases, bring the two sharp points of the triangle together and join them by pushing one side into the other. Use tape to hold them together.

- 4** From the paper left over after making the square, cut off a strip of paper. Tape it to the top of the plane.
- 5** The firefly plane is complete! When you throw it, the wings will flap like a flying insect!



A TALKING BABY OSTRICH CARD!



MAKE YOUR OWN TALKING BABY OSTRICH!

If you don't have a printer, it's easy to draw a talking Baby Ostrich of your own. You could also make a talking Munki, a talking Mama Ostrich, or any animal (or person) that you'd like!

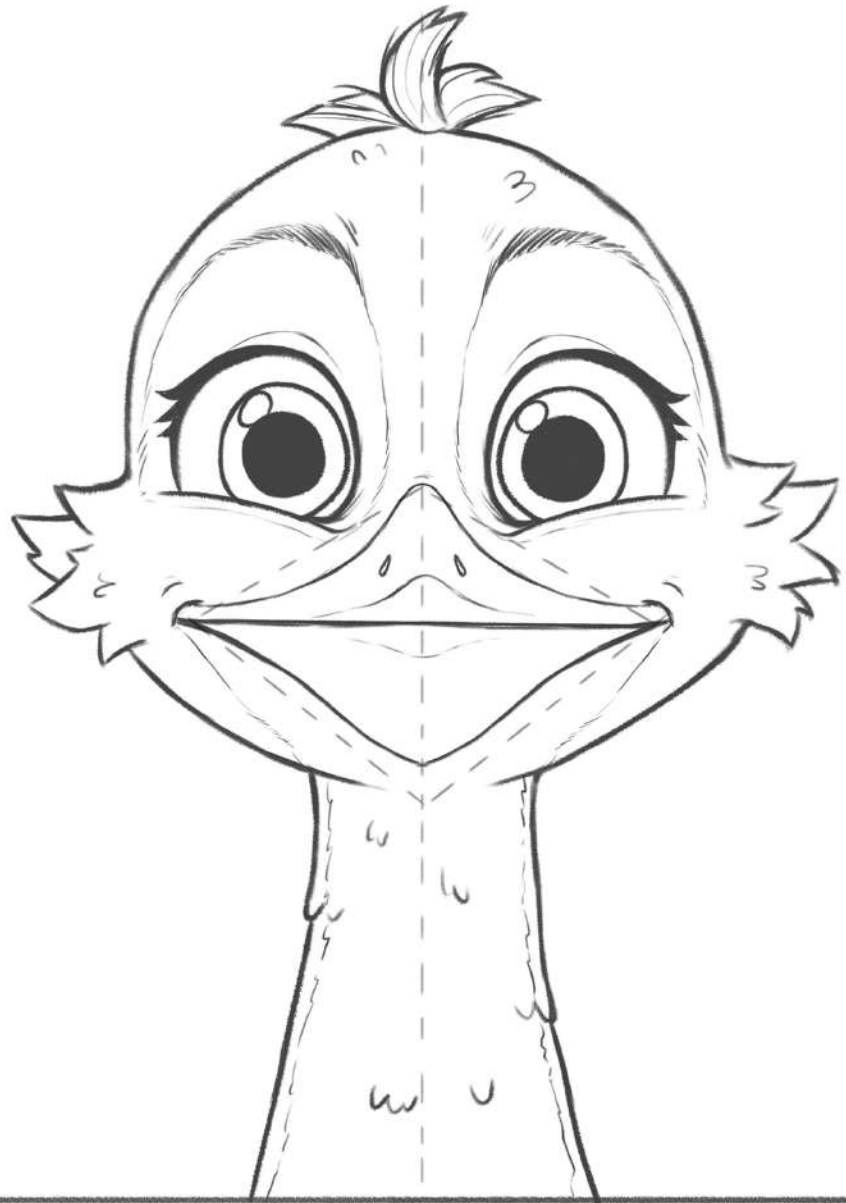
- 1** Fold the page down the middle.
- 2** Fold the sides of the page backwards along the dotted lines.
- 3** Cut along the mouth line.
- 4** Pull the lips of the mouth towards you, and fold along the dotted lines.
- 5** Tape the card closed at the back.
- 6** Now, whenever you open and close the card, the mouth opens and closes, too!

GALAXY SLIME

INGREDIENTS

- ✓ 1 cup of clear glue
- ✓ Purple food colouring (you can make purple by mixing red and blue)
- ✓ Glitter
- ✓ Borax (or liquid starch instead of borax)

METHOD:

- 1** Pour the clear glue into a bowl
- 2** Add a little bit of purple food colouring. You don't need too much!
- 3** Add some glitter
- 4** If you are using borax, make a borax mixture by adding 1 teaspoon of borax to 1 cup of warm water and stir well to combine
- 5** Pour the borax or liquid starch into your bowl, little by little, and keep stirring until your slime is the right consistency
- 6** When your slime begins to form, take it out of the bowl and knead it with your hands. Keep adding a little more borax or liquid starch at a time and kneading until the slime isn't sticky, but not so much that it gets stiff
- 7** If it does get stiff, just add a little water to make it soft and stretchy again!





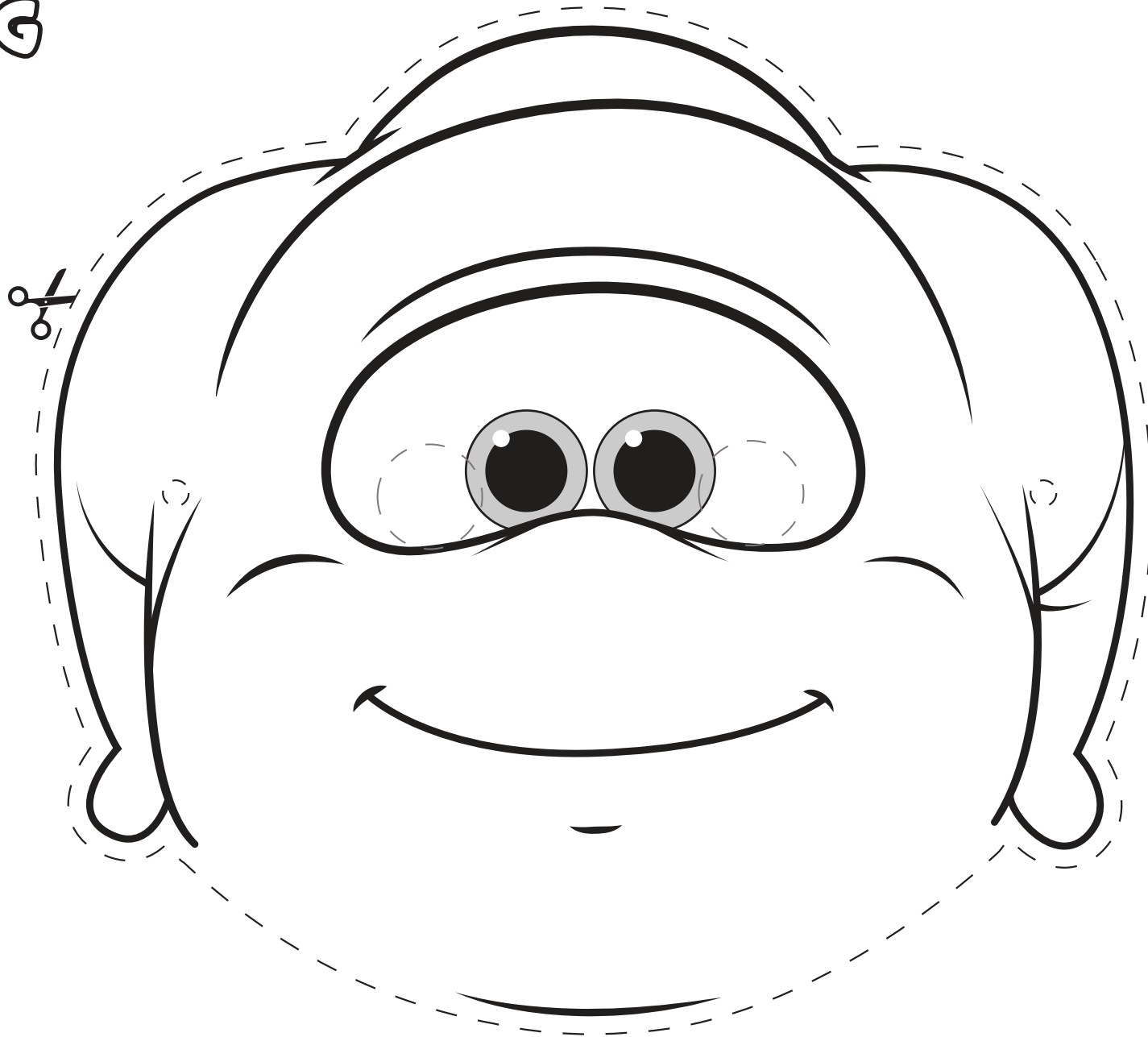
HERE ARE SOME JUNGLE BEAT: THE MOVIE MASKS FOR YOU TO MAKE!
