



A NEW FRIEND FOR DRAGON

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Make a New Friend Bingo

Help kids interact and find common ground with each other!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- Cardstock paper
- Print enough copies for each player
- Consider laminating the cards if you want to reuse them
- Pencils or markers for students

HOW TO PLAY:

Give each student a bingo card and a pencil or marker.

Explain that the goal is to meet new friends and find things they have in common.

Students should mingle and introduce themselves to classmates.

When they find someone who matches a square on their card, they should write that person's name in the square.

Encourage students to find a different person for each square.

The game can end in several ways:

- When someone gets five in a row (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal)
- When someone fills their entire card
- After a set time limit (e.g., 15-20 minutes)

Optionally, have students share something interesting they learned about a new friend.
